

NAVA CANADA/UNITED STATES PUBLICATIONS POLICY

In recognition of the binational (Canada/United States) status of the North American Vexillological Association (NAVA), NAVA publications shall, to the extent practical, adhere to the following:

1. Use the terms "Canadian" and "United States/U.S." before the names of national holidays and governmental institutions, *e.g.*, "Canadian Thanksgiving Day" and "U.S. Internal Revenue Service."
2. Use "Canada" or "USA" after addresses.
3. Differentiate between Canadian and United States dollars by using the terms "C\$" or "US\$," *e.g.*, "The convention registration fee is US\$125.00," or a statement such as "All amounts are in Canadian dollars."
4. Avoid the word "America" or "American" when referring exclusively to the United States.
